Permit Expiration Dates

- a. New Construction - one (1) year, provided that an extension may be requested, in writing, and such extension may be granted by the Township Playground Inspector for good reason; such extension not to exceed one (1) year.
- b. Repairs, Refurbishment, Replacement, Reconstruction, Alterations, and Additions - one (1) year.
- c. Removal or Demolition - three (3) months only, and if such removal and/or demolition work is not completed within that time, any bond posted by the applicant shall be forfeited.

The Township Playground Inspector may revoke a Playground Permit or approval issued under the provisions of this Ordinance in case of any mistake, false statement, or misrepresentation of fact in the Application or on the Plans upon which the Permit or approval was based.

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
